

St. John the Baptist Catholic Early Learning Center Uniform Dress Code 2022-2023

Our Preschool and Pre-K has a uniform policy for all students and is worn as a symbol of unity and school pride. It creates equity among students, a valuable reminder that all students are equally precious in God's eyes. The wearing of uniforms is to be a cooperative effort among parents, students and staff.

Students are required to wear clean, appropriate size and button/hem intact uniforms every day except those specified as a "Free Dress" or "Themed Dress Day" set by the administration. When not in compliance, parents will bring the appropriate uniform items before the child begins their day at school.

Everyday Uniform for all students (includes Mass days)

Boys:

- -Navy blue twill pants (pull-on is a great option) (no cargo) no holes
- -Navy blue knee-length twill shorts (pull-on is a great option) Aug/Sept/Oct & April/May/June only
- -Burgundy interwoven knit polo shirt (short or long sleeve) w/embroidered St. John shield logo
- -Same color or white turtleneck shirts can be worn under uniform shirts in cold weather.
- -Navy ½ zip fleece or long sleeve pull-over w/embroidered St. John shield logo (optional)
- -Navy or white crew socks
- -No belt needed
- -Shoes (tennis with Velcro or tied laces or a neutral color school shoes) (no sandals, crocs)
- -Boots limited to inclement weather will change into shoes on arrival

Girls:

- -Navy blue twill pants (pull-on is a great option) (no cargo) no holes
- -Navy blue knee-length twill shorts (pull-on is a great option) Aug/Sept & April/May/June only
- -Burgundy interwoven knit polo shirt (short or long sleeve) w/embroidered St. John shield logo
- -Same color or white turtleneck shirts can be worn under uniform shirts in cold weather.
- -Dunbar plaid skort (optional)
- -Dunbar plaid jumper (navy bike shorts under) (optional)
- -Navy ½ zip fleece or long sleeve pull-over w/embroidered St. John shield logo (optional)
- -Navy or white crew socks
- -Navy or white tights or leggings
- -No belt needed
- -Hair Accessories match the uniform (optional)
- -Shoes (tennis with Velcro or tied laces or a neutral color school shoes) (no sandals, crocs)
- -Boots limited to inclement weather will change into shoes on arrival

Important notes:

- Change of clothes kept in backpacks and/or classroom <u>does not</u> have to be uniform (free dress clothes).
- Please label all clothing with your child's name. Be aware that staff may label unmarked items.

Free Dress Days

When a free dress day is announced, students may be out of uniform. Dress, however, should be appropriate for school. The expectation is that the clothing is clean and in good condition with no rips, tears or holes. This includes jeans, dresses/skirts for the girls and non-character shirts.

Theme Dress Days

When a theme dress day is announced, special colors for special days are allowed on this day (St. Patrick's-green, St. Valentine's-red, Christmas-red/green, etc.) This also includes SJB Viking Spirit Day wearing blue and gold or Viking clothing. All items should be clean and reflect the same definition of the uniform. Usually this can be a themed shirt with jeans or a themed dress for the girls. This would also include Pajama Day a couple times a year (no slippers; shoes only).
